Dear Sally Dixon,

This is to let you know that I'll be arriving in Pittsburg on Sept. 22nd at 2:09 P. M. on United flight # 484 . . .

AND to send you the happy news that (in addition to "The Weir-Falcon Saga" and "The Machine of Eden") you'll be having a world premiere showing of the third film in that series: "The Animals of Eden and After" -- color, silent, and 35 min. long . . . : that'll make the total length of the program about an hour and 12 minutes, plus lecture, etc.
